

THE NEW YORK PRESIDENTIAL DEBATE



Nassau County

A **pre-planned event** worked in conjunction with Metropolitan Data and Salamander Representative, Mark McColman, on September 26, 2016.

On September 26th, 2016, Salamander Technologies and Metropolitan Data Solutions assisted the Nassau County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) with the Presidential Debate held in Nassau County, New York.

Preemptive measures were taken ensure the safety of attendees, as well as the safety of the individuals working and/or volunteering for the debate, as their safety was a particularly high-priority for the OEM. The ability to track and report the status of individuals through Salamander Technologies was vital to the success of their overall operational preparedness.

Solution

RAPID TAG stations were linked with COMMAND to give the EOC a full operational picture. First responders were credentialed on-site through RAPID TAG to produce event-specific ID cards. With the 02 TRACK APP, resources with RAPID TAG IDs were quickly scanned into their assignments and off-scene locations.

Outcome

By utilizing the Intelligent Accountability™ suite, Section Chiefs were able to instantaneously incorporate accurate data into their Incident Action Plan. In addition, Commanders maintained a complete operational picture of the event in real time from their web-based SalamanderLive™ dashboard.
